

Positive Mental Health



Mental Health of Children and Young People in England: November 2018




1 in 18 Pre School Children were seen as having a mental disorder 2.5% of Children consisted of Oppositional Defiant Disorder

Children Who Have Experienced a Mental Health Problem (Mental Health Foundation)














Sleep


Limit processed foods


