

Find out how you can take advantage of your non-levy position, making apprenticeships in your business a realistic possibility.





### What contribution may the employer have to contribute?

Non-levy paying employers will share the cost of training and assessing their apprentices with government (co-investment)

The co-investment rate has changed for new apprenticeships starting on or after 1 April 2019. They will now pay 5% towards the cost of apprenticeship training. The government will pay the rest (95%) up to the funding band maximum

At the moment the 5% costs of the EYE is £300 the employer would need to contribute, this can be paid all at once or on a quarterly basis and in each case they will be issued with an invoice when any agreed payment is due.

If an employer is interested in different qualification areas, please check if this is on a standard (involves EPA) and if the 5% contribution may differ for this qual area.

| Early Years Level 2 (12 months in learning/3 EPA) | £4,000            | £3,800             | £200        |
| Early Years Level 3 (15 months in learning/3 EPA) | £6,000            | £5,700             | £300        |
| Management Level 3 (18 months in learning/3 EPA)  | £4,500            | £4,275             | £225        |
| Management Level 5 (18 months in learning/3 EPA)  | £7,000            | £6,650             | £350        |
| Catering Level 2 (15 months in learning/3 EPA)    | £5,000            | £5,750             | £250        |
| Catering Level 3(15 months in learning/3 EPA)     | £4,000            | £3,800             | £200        |

#### How is the employer able to access the non-levy?

Please note the following must apply for all new starts on the non-levy accounts:

- · Apprenticeship Standards only
- · Can reserve funding for up to 3 apprentices per employer
- · 5% contribution still required

The employer will require:

- · Organisation Companies House or Charity number
- · Government Gateway Login for your PAYE schemes (You will need to register for HMRC's online services if you don't already have Government Gateway credentials) using the link below https://www.gov.uk/log-in-register-hmrc-online-services/register
